SUBJECT: Schedule of Expenditures of Federal Awards (SEFA)

The purpose of this bulletin is to notify school districts of the requirement to prepare a Schedule of Expenditures of Federal Awards (SEFA) for the fiscal year ending August 31, 2012. School districts that spend \$500,000 or more in federal awards are required to have an annual audit of their federal programs. If we did not perform a single audit last year and your federal grant expenditures are \$500,000 or more, please notify your local audit manager

To ensure you meet the federal filing deadline, audits of financial statements and federal programs need to be completed by March 1, 2013. Your auditor will need the final version of your financial statements, schedules and notes to the financial statements completed by that date.

The deadline to submit the SEFA to the Auditor's Office is November 15, 2012.

Due to their later financial statement due dates, Educational Service Districts have a deadline of November 30, 2012 to submit their SEFAs.

Please do not submit the SEFA to the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction.
