I am looking for information on my family members who are deceased.

I am the grandson of Merel Dick Oppen who died in Bellingham, WA on 5/19/81. I would like any information that appears please. Wills, Marriage Certificates, Past Work History, who his parents were, any and all info that you can legally provide me.

My grandmother's name was Ardis (RD) Meryl Schilling Oppen Millage. She was born 12/30/35 and her parents were Albert & Mary (Voss) Schilling. On 12/23/52 she married my grandfather MD Oppen. They had 4 children, Jean McCann, Dick Oppen, Rose Lauzier, Rick Oppen. She later married John Millage on 11/29/85 until her death.

I am a grandson, my father is Dick Oppen. I don't know much about my family and I would like to trace my heritage and thought this would be a place to start for any kind of records, can you help me?

I am a prisoner with little funds so if you can waive any fees I would greatly appreciate it. If not, I can pay up to \$10 a month out of my check for this info.

I would like to know if there was a way wills, stocks, bonds, land or post debts that they may have owed. Also what my heritage may be? Thank you for your time and consideration in this matter.
