Dear Ms. Frame,

We have received and completed our response to your public records request sent in via email, as follows:

Pursuant to the state Open Records Act, Wash. Rev. Code Ann. Secs 42.56.001 to 42.56.902, I request access to and electronic copies of a database or other such record related to employees at your agency/commission/office/board/department on job reassignment or alternate assignment from years 2012 to present – for cases where the employee is on reassignment while being investigated for allegations of wrong-doing.

This request should include records providing the following:

- ***Employee name***
- ***Position***
- ***Pay rate/salary***
- ***Beginning and ending dates of the alternate assignment***
- ***Disposition: Termination? Settlement? Back to work?***

As provided by statute, I request to receive these records as they become available as opposed to waiting for the entire request to be ready for inspection or disclosure. Please don't hesitate to call or email with any questions or needed clarification.

You clarified on 6/3/2016:

Many of you have already responded to my request for public records regarding job reassignments – and thank you for those responses. I wanted to make a clarification about the request. I am not requesting records/information about “home assignments”. I am requesting records/information about employees who are still at work, but have been put in an alternate position due to a pending investigation.

Under your clarifications we have no responsive records. We will now consider this request closed. Please let us know if you have any further questions.
