Dear Mr. Smith,

The Office of the Washington State Auditor has received and completed our response to your public records request, as follows:

Pursuant to the Washington State Public Records Act (Chapter 42.56 RCW), I am formally requesting access to all records, documents, communications, and metadata pertaining to the following:

- 1. **Biometric and Identity Records*****
 - Fingerprint cards, signature logs, and biometric identifiers used in any legal, medical, or military classification***
 - Records showing alias-only identification or substitution of legal name***
 - Any documentation tied to ASL classification, including intake forms, assessments, or overrides***
- 2. **Credentialing and Classification Documentation*****
 - Records showing credentialing decisions, restrictions, or concealment***
 - Internal communications regarding classification overrides, metadata anomalies (e.g., timestamps such as 12/31/1899), and record suppression***
 - Any documentation tied to MEPS processing, recruiter logs, or chain-of-command decisions***
- 3. **Investigative and Procedural Records*****
 - All investigative files, notes, and communications tied to my legal proceedings***
 - Records showing refusal to correct or acknowledge misclassification***
 - Communications involving named officials (e.g., Dunwell, Kelvin) regarding my case***

This request is made under the authority of:

- **RCW 42.56.001** – Affirming the public’s right to transparency and oversight***
- **RCW 42.56.040** – Requiring agencies to publish procedures for accessing records***
- **RCW 42.56.070** – Mandating public access to indexes and identifiable records***
- **RCW 42.56.080** – Guaranteeing access to identifiable records and facilities for copying***

- ****RCW 42.56.090**** – **Requiring timely inspection and availability of records**
- ****RCW 42.56.100**** – **Ensuring protection of records without obstructing access**
- ****RCW 42.56.230 & 42.56.240**** – **Addressing exemptions and investigative records**
- ****RCW 42.56.520**** – **Requiring a response within five business days**

I request that these records be provided in **electronic format**, with full metadata intact. If any portion of this request is denied, please provide a written explanation citing the specific exemption under RCW 42.56 and the legal basis for withholding.

This request is supported by documented exhibits (G-30A through G-30G) which demonstrate procedural sabotage, biometric misattribution, and credentialing concealment. These exhibits will be submitted in parallel to oversight bodies and legal counsel.

Please confirm receipt of this request and provide a timeline for response as required by RCW 42.56.520.

In response, our office received this request but it was not addressed to us. Our office would not have any responsive records to fulfill this request. Since we have no records, we will now consider this closed. SAO does not intend to further address the request, and the PRA's one-year statute of limitations to seek judicial review has started to run as of the date of this letter.
