The Office of the Washington State Auditor has received and completed our response to your public records request sent in via letter, as follows:

My name Jo, I'm on the ORCSP (Offender Re-entry Community Safety Program). I have some questions that "Olympia" says you'll be able to answer.

- 1. How much does it cost to keep a prisoner, my age "58" in prison for a year?**
- 2. I have been on the ORCS Program since 10/8/16. Nobody has any answers.**

I need to know how much of the \$60,000 for 5 years on the ORCS Program goes for, or the allowances are for:

- Housing/Rent/Utilities**
- Clothing**
- Food**
- Bedding**
- Transportation**
- Appliances (tv, dvd play, microwave)**
- Vocational tools (small motor mechanic/automotive repair)**
- Art/Hobby supplies**

3. I'm supposed to be releasing to the Corbin Hotel, which is not wheelchair accessible. How much will it cost for a simple wooden ramp with handrails to be installed?

4. I need this vital information so I can develop a viable monthly, yearly and 5 year budget.
