The Office of the Washington State Auditor has received and completed our response to your public records request sent in via email, as follows:

I just move to this area only to observe that the water and sewer bill is one of the highest in the nation, right behind Seattle.

Honestly, I would like to see what everyone in this town is paying. The \$145.90 I pay each month for water, sewer and trash service is way more than a east coast transplant is even herd of. My water use is very conservative.

Moreover I am green and if there are things I need to do to bring down my usage I need to get to that. I have already deployed the standard method of water reduction, gray water gardening, low flow shower heads and low flush toilets. I employ all of the standards, all of them, from when and how I wash clothes, to not using a dishwasher, to how we shower and brush our teeth.

I am honestly stumped about this issue and thought to start with these reports before I start asking questions that some might take offense to.

Our office does not have any responsive records to fulfill your request with us. You will need to contact the Town of Washtucna directly for those records. I will now consider this request closed. Please let me know if you have any questions, concerns or issues regarding this request.
