Dear Mr. Odom,

The Office of the Washington State Auditor has received and completed our response to your public records request sent in via email, as follows:

Today I write in regards to, two consecutive DOSA matters that I was originally sentenced to, at two separate times. After a full research about the policy and procedure of DOSA supervision, I have found a significant error, that I grovelingly ask for a correction.

In July of 2010, I was sentenced in the Pierce County Superior Court for several felony convictions. I was sentenced to 60 months in prison, and was released on October 21st, 2013. Subsequently, those convictions came with DOC supervision.

During the supervision period, I was again charged in Benton County Superior Court in 2014, as well as Spokane County in 2015. In between filing for these new charges I was CCP returned for the Pierce County case, and was subsequently released on July 1st, 2016.

After the CCP return, I plead guilty to my pending charges in the Spokane matter on December 2nd, 2016. I received a 25.5 DOSA sentence. As I was classified and sent to AHCC, I was then returned to court in Benton County February 15th, 2017, and on July 27th, 2017, I received 73.5 months with DOSA, ran consecutive to my Spokane matter.

Unfortunately on April 30th, 2018, I was revoked. The hearing officer revoked both DOSA sentences, regardless of the fact I had completed the incarceration part of the Spokane matter. Based on policy and procedure, I cannot be revoked on my Spokane matter, on the supervision end of my DOSA sentence for the fact that, my supervision on the Spokane matter had not started simply because, my Pierce County matter is not completed and is considered "tolling".

I ask that your office audits my file thoroughly and find this in correction, and corrects this issue. I thank you for your time and cooperation.

In response, our office does not have any kind of records pertaining to Michael Odom. Our office audits state and local governments use public funds, and develops strategies that make government more efficient and effective. Since we have no responsive records to fulfill your request with us, we will now close this request. Please let us know if you have questions, concerns or issues regarding this request.
